**Monthly Report - January 2011**

1. **GUILDHALL - No further information has been received**
2. **PATHFIELDS - The stream/bridges project should begin very shortly**
3. **PLAY AREA - We are still hoping to get the swings back and appropriate play equipment, but funds for insurance and maintenance are proving difficult to obtain at present.**
4. **“DORSMOUTH” OUTLINE PLANNING APPLICATION - The planning application to erect two dwellings on this site - Plympton Covert - has been approved. We spoke against this application, together with Councillor Terry Beer, in view of the impact on the Conservation Area, the road widening and pavements being imposed, together with the loss of parking spaces. We intend to Continue to oppose this development when it comes up for Detailed Planning Permission.**
5. **MIDSUMMER FESTIVAL : The Lamb Feast will take place on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2011 and the Hidden Gardens on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2011.**
