1. PATHFIELDS:

The public meeting arranged by Plymouth City Council to explain its desire to lease the Guildhall to a panel of trustees was very well attended. The Association is still in talks with officers of the council, but so far there is not much progress.

Police were called and youths apprehended after stones from the castle had been thrown into gardens surrounding the mound. English Heritage and the Parks Department are now involved in repairing the damage.
