1. **GUILDHALL** - Keeping Plympton Guildhall open is of paramount importance and we shall continue to work with the Council and keep the community informed on progress.
2. **PATHFIELDS POND** - We are continuing to work with Parks Department on this project with a view to draining the pond - work should start in the late autumn.
