### REPORT ON MONTHLY MEETING – 21<sup>st</sup> August 2008

**Pathfields Pond** – Our representative was able to put the Association's points to the Planning Councillors prior to a decision being taken. We stated the importance of securing adequate funding from the Pocklington Trust for the future maintenance of the pond and also hoped they would provide a link with the natural water course by appropriate planting and to make it possible for people to walk dry shod in this area. Planning permission was granted and we shall make sure we continue to be involved with this development.

**War Memorial** – We are in touch with the City Council concerning the refurbishment of the chain link around this important local site.

**Britain in Bloom** – Judges had walked around the Conservation Area and Pathfields – they appeared most impressed. Results will be announced on 18<sup>th</sup> September.

**Music Festival** – Tickets are going well for the main events. Refer to last month's Report for full information.

**TREASURER'S REPORT** – The balance stands at £12,230.98

**PLYMPTON CIVIC SOCIETY** – Planning permission has been granted for houses to be built on the Old Priory site.

**AREA MEETING** – When responding to the consultation for the Eastern Transport Corridor the Association had asked for reference to the bollards at the top of Bullers Hill to be included. At the next Area Meeting, pavement widening in Ridgeway will be discussed. It is also expected that there will be a review and update on the library. This meeting is at Harewood House Monday 15<sup>th</sup> September at 7.00 p.m.
