REPORT ON MONTHLY MEETING – 21ST FEBRUARY 2008

1. **PATHFIELDS** – The flytipping from the allotment area will be removed. The City Parks Department will then be approached to work towards the area being available for people to walk through.
2. **POND(Pathfields West)** The City and Pocklington Rise are still in negotiation with regard to developing a pond. We are being kept informed.
3. **SOCIAL REPORT: Moulin Rouge Evening – 15th March** – This should be a good evening of entertainment plus a 3 course meal and a glass of wine for £10.
Lamb Feast/Music Festival 2008 – Arrangements for various events are in ongoing process.
4. **TREASURER'S REPORT** – The balance stands at £10,124.76.
- 5 **PLYMPTON CIVIC SOCIETY** – It was reported that 53 houses will be built on the Market Road site. The Ridgeway School path closure has been turned down but there will be an appeal.
6. **PLYMPTON COMMUNITY COUNCIL** – There are three applicants for the position of Stanator: Sylvia Guthrig – Roger T. Coleman – Robert William Shaw.
7. **AREA MEETING** – This was a special meeting to discuss reduction in fire cover for Plympton. It was pointed out the vulnerability of the Conservation Area and it appears there may be a reprieve for Plympton.
- 8.**ANY OTHER BUSINESS: Land South of Fore Street** – A notice will be placed at either end of this public right of way concerning the clump of small trees which were planted by the environmental agency in what was a completely open space.
- 9.**Allotment Huts-Pathfields** – The Association is in the process of checking whether it may be useful to take these Huts as storing space.
- 10.**Stanchions in Redvers Grove** – This area will now have its own stanchions on which to hang baskets for our Open Gardens displays.
- 11.**Plympton Guildhall** – There is an ongoing dialogue with Councillors and the City regarding this Grade II listed building and its future.
- 12.**Future of Old Grammar School** – After consulting the Chairman of the Hele Trust, who own this building, it was confirmed that it was very much hoped that it would be transferred to another body who would keep it as a public building. We shall continue to offer support for this venture.
