REPORT ON MONTHLY MEETING – JULY 2009

Pathfields Update - A meeting has been arranged to meet the contractors for Pocklington. It will be brought to their notice that brushwood has been left in the top field, making it impossible for the mowing to take place there. Half of the saplings planted to replace the hedge have failed and there is still a definite 'hump' at the entry point. The pond is still a disappointment to the community and various suggestions will be put forward.

Woodland Walk – The first phase – clearing unwanted rubbish, using stone on site to repair walls on the eastern side of the walk and inserting wooden steps at the entrance has been completed. Most of the work will, however, take place in the autumn/winter.

Plympton Guildhall – The Feasibility Study is still ongoing.

Britain in Bloom – The judging took place on the 15th July for South West in Bloom and Britain in Bloom judging will be on **13th August**. It is hoped that as many residents as possible will make sure their baskets/troughs are looking good for this prestigious award. The judges will be looking at St. Maurice as a whole including pathfields. We shall do our best to check the area before the day.

SOCIAL REPORT: Big Picnic – 18th July – Everything is in place for this event. Although it is hoped to use the Castle Green, the Guildhall has been booked in the event of rain.
