**PATHFIELDS POND** – It was agreed we would send a letter raising the following points: although the committee were happy for a pond to be located in Pathfields we were disappointed that it was unable to be sited along the line of the natural stream. We would like the pond and the stream to be linked and money ring fenced to cover all costs of future maintenance.

**LAND SOUTH OF FORE STREET** – Research showed that this piece of land was originally called Barn Meadow. It was felt appropriate to revert to this original name for the future.

**COFFEE WEEK AT HARE WOOD HOUSE** – A total of £353.76 had been raised. Judy Eden was thanked for making it possible to go ahead with this event.

**MIDSUMMER FESTIVAL** – It was agreed that this had been a most successful weekend in spite of the weather. We were also delighted that the charities represented and Plympton St. Maurice Church were pleased with the day.
