

## PLYMPTON ST. MAURICE CIVIC ASSOCIATION

### REPORT ON MONTHLY MEETING – 20<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2008

1. **SHERFORD** – Planning permission will probably be granted shortly.
2. **PATHFIELDS:**
  - Pond:** Plans are going ahead and there will be an opportunity to make representations after it has been submitted to the City.
  - Allotments** – Flytipping has been removed and a route marked for a path.
3. **Church Flagpole** – A Union flag has been purchased and will be raised on the appropriate dates in place of the St. George's flag
4. **Castle Green (removal of tarmac from the swing area)** English Heritage are liaising with City Parks Department to restore the grass.
5. **40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the founding of the Association – 17<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> July.** There will be a flower festival in the Church and a party on the Castle Green on 19<sup>th</sup> July.
6. **SOCIAL REPORT:**
  - Music Festival** – The sub-committee are still discussing whether to go ahead with a Festival this year. The main committee has resolved to support the Festival should it take place.
  - Lamb Feast** – Preliminary arrangements are already well advanced for this event, which will take place on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> June.
  - Moulin Rouge** – The committee thanked Lee and Julia for making such a successful event, much enjoyed by all.
7. **TREASURER'S REPORT** – The balance stands at £9,781.18.
8. **PLYMPTON CIVIC SOCIETY** – To commemorate the retirement of the secretary Phil Armson after twenty-five years, a Davidia (Handkerchief Tree) will be planted.
9. **PLYMPTON COMMUNITY COUNCIL** – The May Fair will take place on 10<sup>th</sup> May. Roger Coleman has been chosen as the Stannator for 2008.
10. **AREA MEETING** – The extension of the boundaries of the Conservation Area will include land south of Fore Street and Pathfields. Fore Street, Longbrook Street and Barbican Road will probably be included in a 20-mile an hour limit.
11. **THREE PLAQUES AT THE ENTRANCE TO ST. MAURICE** – It was pointed out that these are in need of refurbishment. Lee Everett and Freddie Mills agreed to do this work.
12. **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES** – It was agreed we shall be reviewing, in our 40<sup>th</sup> year, all that is relevant and we hope to have a stand at the Lamb Feast to present some of our achievements and look to the future with positive ideas.
