PATHFIELDS(WOODLAND WALK) A meeting took place with a Landscape Designer. A definite path to be established and gradually to build up a planting regime which may mean some overhanging branches being cut back to allow appropriate light. We shall now meet with City Parks to put forward our plans. Our main aim is to make the area attractive to walk through rather than being a place to avoid.

CASTLE MOUND – A meeting took place to discuss the reduction of the hedge, the removal of shrubs on the western side of the mound and brambles and valerian to be removed from the castle ruins.
