MONTHLY REPORT – MAY 2010

Constitution – We have agreed a revised Constitution and this will be sent to all members prior to the AGM in January 2011.

Pathfields – We are seeking a site meeting with the Chief Executive of Pocklington in order to talk through the community's dissatisfaction with the pond and also to make sure Scots Pines are planted to replace the Pines which were felled in 2009.

We are in consultation with City Parks Department to open the stream which runs through both west fields. Two bridges, made from used railway sleepers, would enable visitors to enjoy the area without the need for wellingtons!

Play Area – We are still committed to the idea of some form of play area and understand there are grants available. However, we are awaiting confirmation that the City would agree to insure and maintain such a project.

Woodland Walk – More cultivation has been called for in this area and we shall continue to develop it.

Midsummer Festival – 18th to 20th June. Publicity is well advanced for this special weekend.
