POCKLINGTON POND – We are now taking this matter to Plymouth Parks Department with a view to resolving the issue of non-viable pond life.

PLAY AREA – As a first step we are inviting representatives from companies who specifically deal with play equipment in Conservation Areas.

SEATS IN PATHFIELDS – It is hoped to place two seats in Pathfields to give people more opportunity to just sit and admire the views.

COUNTRYSIDE PARK – This initiative will be beneficial to St. Maurice as it will hopefully give long term protection from development. The Park will include Saltram, Hardwick Woods, the Longbrook and Wolverwood. Chelson Meadow is also included. We are disappointed that the whole of the Conservation Area was not included and will continue to debate this omission.
